- Submission of a 500-word essay responding to the following prompt: What is the main reason you are choosing natural resources or conservation biology as a career ,and what life experiences have been most meaningful in this decision?

Description on CLSA Website:

One-time, \$1000 non-renewable. The Calvert Nature Society Scholarship Program provides financial assistance and encouragement to graduating seniors of Calvert County high schools who maintain at least a 3.00 GPA. Eligible applicants will have an interest in furthering their education in natural resources or conservation biology at an accredited college or university. Applicants will be prioritized based on applicants' commitment to academic performance, extracurricular activities, etc. The separate essay is required.
