CBW is offering a total of four (4) scholarships to African American High School Seniors who are graduating

from Calvert County Public High Schools and will be attending Institutions of Higher Learning.

Selection is based upon the following criteria:

1. Be a 2021 graduating senior from Calvert County Public Schools
2. Be accepted for enrollment in a four-year college/university on a full-time basis (must attach the college/university Letter of Acceptance)
3. Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
4. Demonstrated achievements in extracurricular and community activities
5. A written essay (maximum 500 words) focusing on:

- a. My chosen field of study is ... because ...
- b. How my community, church, or family has influenced me....
- c. Why it is important for me to attend college.

Each of the three (3) areas listed above MUST be addressed in the essay.

The essay will be rated on content, depth, grammar, organization, and originality.

Description on CLSA Website:

(Four [4] \$1500, non-renewable) Concerned Black Women of Calvert County will award four scholarships to 2021 African American graduating senior from Calvert County schools.

Eligible applicants will be selected based on scholastic, athletic and/or leadership achievement. The CBW Selection Committee may request an

interview with eligible applicants. The separate maximum 500-word essay is required focusing on:

1. My chosen field of study is ... because ...;
2. How my community, church, or family has influenced me....;
3. Why it is important for me to attend college?
